

Preparing for a yard Treatment

When you pay good money to have your yard treated for ants and other bothersome insects most people want it to be as effective as possible. That being said there are a few small things you can do to help make your treatment be successful,

Some things you need to do before a yard treatment,

Before the Treatment

- Mow the grass. Most insects live down in the mat of the grass. If the grass is too high, this will prohibit the product from penetrating that area.
- Pick up all kids toys and place them in one area. We don't treat toys. If they are picked up that will ensure as much of your yard is treated as possible.
- Keep pets indoors and pet doors locked. We don't want the dog to run out while we are there, remember we will have the gate open during the treatment.
- Pet droppings should be picked up. Pet feces will draw all kinds of insects, not to mention it contains harmful bacteria.

After the treatment

- All pets and people should stay off the treated area for four hours.
- Check the gate! Remember we were there and we will do our best to close it, but PLEASE CHECK IT, just to be sure.
